Blessings to each of you in the powerful name of Jesus! We pray that this letter finds you walking in His best and enjoying life to the fullest. I want to share with you today about “The importance of prayer in our daily walk with God”.

Psalms 5:1-3. In this passage of scripture, David taught us several things:

1. He taught us to seek God early and to begin our day with prayer. If we seek the Lord early in our day, the presence and power of God can influence us throughout the day.

When we seek the Lord early, we honor Him by putting Him first. Morning Prayer puts discipline in our lives and helps us set our priorities. Morning Prayer sets the course of our day and gives us a jump on the devil..

David was a man who made mistakes, but he was a man who had a heart for God. He understood the importance of seeking God and fellowshiping with Him. Rising early and meeting with God is mentioned 86 times in the Bible.

2. He taught us to pray expectantly.... “In the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will LOOK UP”. “To look up” means to lean forward, look into the distance, or to observe and watch closely.

That’s how we should pray: We should have expectancy when we pray. We do not need to look down and be disheartened. We need to look up and expect our answer to manifest quickly. Ps. 121:1-2.

3. David taught us to pray at all times: Psalms 55:16-17 Prayer is a spiritual force. It is powerful; it changes things and situations; it transforms lives; prayer saves, heals, and sets people free. Prayer can do and undo anything.

Dr. Cho says: “Prayer is spiritually breathing.” I agree with that. Prayer should be the normal outflow of our spiritual life. I wonder how many times that dangers and catastrophes have escaped us because we prayed. Let me encourage you to do what 1 Thess. 5:17 says: “Pray without ceasing”. The Lord enjoys our time with Him.
