RELEASE OF LIABILITY

This is a legally binding document. If you have a question you should contact an attorney.

- A. If you are over 70 years of age, or have had severe health problems, we must have a written statement from your physician stating that you are able to attend a rigorous work trip at an altitude of approximately 7,500 feet above sea level.
- B. Insurance: The insurance covers accidental death and dismemberment, medical expenses, and hospital confinement. The U.S. Office of Living Water Teaching (LWT) will purchase the insurance on your behalf, and Living Water Teaching will be the beneficiary of said insurance to the EXTENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY LWT. Any benefit funds remaining, after reimbursement to LWT for all expenses incurred, will be distributed to the individual insured.
- C. Refunds: NO refunds of any amount for any reason will be made for cancellations received fourteen (14) days prior to the departure date. Living Water Teaching is required to make cash reimbursement for food, lodging, and transportation in the country to which you are traveling far in advance of your departure, and is unable to recoup those costs. Refunds for cancellations received fifteen (15) days, or more prior to departure will be made for reason of illness, injury, or death less the \$100.00 nonrefundable deposit, and less the cost of any nonrefundable airline tickets purchased on behalf of the participant. One may also have the option of transferring funds to a future trip, if notice is given MORE than 14 days and less than 30 days prior to departure; minus the \$100 deposit, but only for reasons of death, illness or injury. No funds will be returned.
- D. If you are not paid in full 30 days before departure, a \$50 fee will be added to your balance.
- E. Transportation delays:
 - 1. Living Water Teaching does not act as an agent for any travel or transportation corporation.
 - 2. Living Water Teaching shall not be liable for any cost associated with transportation delays due to weather conditions, civil disturbances, military actions, labor disputes, strikes, government regulation, or any other reason beyond the control of Living Water Teaching.
 - 3. Living Water Teaching does not in any way act as a guarantor regarding travel activities.
 - 4. The applicant shall bear any and all costs associated with his or her transportation delays.
- F. Waiver of Claim for Damages and Release of Liability: In consideration of Living Water Teaching, Inc. granting me permission to participate in a mission trip, I hereby waive any and all claims for damage or loss for personal injuries or property damage which may be caused by any act, or failure to act, of Living Water Teaching, Inc., its officers, directors, agents or employees.

By signing this application, I agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein, and this Waiver and Release shall be binding upon spouse, my legal representatives, heirs, and me whether the signed document is mailed, or faxed.
